#### Assessors

An Assessor checks on your progress and agrees the completion of a section of your programme.

They will produce an Assessor's report for that section.

An Assessor can be anyone who is interested in helping you to achieve, has some knowledge of the activity you are doing and can be available over the time you're doing it.

From the local football club coach to a charity shop manager, from the neighbour who's a web designer to your home economics teacher, just about anyone can be an Assessor.

However, they MUST be independent. Therefore, they CANNOT be a member of your family.
